

Dear Parents/Guardians,

This notice serves as a reminder that at a prior IEP meeting for your child, you may have provided consent for CPS to bill Medicaid (All Kids) for the reimbursement of health services provided to your child at no cost to you.

No change is being made; this is simply a reminder that we will continue to follow the direction you provided. If we previously received your consent to bill Medicaid at no cost to you for health services, we will continue to bill Medicaid. If we have not received your consent previously, we will discuss this with you at your child's next IEP conference, and will not bill Medicaid in the meantime.

As you know, CPS conducts evaluations and provides related services to students who need them at no cost to parents/guardians. For some services, CPS is able to receive federal Medicaid reimbursement to help cover our costs in providing the services. Whether or not CPS receives that federal reimbursement has no impact on the IEP services your child receives or on your family's insurance or benefit programs.
